CIEU FISHING TOURNAMENT 2009

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY

The tournament is opened to all CIEU members ONLY. This condition shall be strictly observed throughout the tournament. Any participant who after being registered ceases to be a member of the union shall be disqualified from the tournament.

2. ENTRY FEE

The entry fee per person is \$25 which is inclusive of Fishing Fees, lunch, a bottle of mineral water and prizes.

3. RULES

Each participant may only use **one** rod at any one time.

4. PRIZES

The recipients for the prizes will be judged according to the weight of the fish(es) caught by the participants. Each participant may only win **one** prize, using the heaviest fish caught.

5. REFUNDS

No refunds shall be made after an entry has been registered and verified.

6. REPORTING TIME

All participants must report 30 minutes before the respective scheduled time to fish.

7. PROTEST

- (i) Protest must be made to the Organising Committee immediately before or after the alleged infringement. Each protest should be accompanied with a protest fee of \$50 which will be forfeited if the protest is found to be invalid.
- (ii) No protest will be entertained after the presentation of prizes.

8 APPEAL/DISCIPLINARY

The decision of the Appeal/Disciplinary Committee shall be final. No further appeal(s) will be entertained.

9. AMENDMENT

The Organising Committee reserves the right to amend the rules and regulations of the tournament as and when it deems necessary.

10. DISCLAIMER/ INDEMNITY

The Organising Committee and the Union will not be held responsible for any claims arising out of any death, injury, damage or loss, suffered or caused while

participating in the tournament and this includes all costs and expenses incurred as a result of such claim.

11. CLOSING DATE

The closing date for the event is **Monday, 13 July 2009**. Acceptance of the entries will be on a ***first-come first served*** basis.
